DAY	EVENTS
Aug. 3	<p>MERKWIIEF, FRANCE - 306th group flew 36 A/C as 40th "A" group with Major Saluda leading the formation in an attack on a synthetic oil plant. A visual run was made over 3/10 clouds. 10 A/C were damaged, Lt. R.B. Nabors, navigator in the 423rd was killed, and S/Sgt. D. W. Urdell of the 368th was wounded.</p>
4	<p>ANHEIM A/D - 306th group flew 36 A/C as 40th "C" group. A good visual run was made on the fighter component plant and on the airfield with good results shown by photos. Major Chalfant led the group. The high squadron reported seeing a number of enemy A/C.</p>
5	<p>DOLLBERG, GERMANY - Major Flanagan led this highly successful attack into Germany in the continued offensive against enemy oil refineries and synthetic plants. No E/A were observed by this group which flew 36 A/C of the 40th "C" group. One plane bombed the A/C at Diepholz.</p>
6	<p>BUNDENBURG, GERMANY - This proved to be one of the longer raids the group has participated in, as the route took the formations around the east side of Berlin while hitting the target on the way out to the west. The target was a motor works on the north side of the airfield. Hits were seen on three sides of the field with the P/A camp on the west side left undamaged. Lt. Col. Alford led the 36 ships of the 40th "B" and this group also provided 12 A/C in the 40th "C". Last report targets hit by individual ships were Stendal A/S, Hefmof, Weesermunde, Oderburg, and Prutzke.</p>
7	<p>MONTAUBIER-ST. LOUBES, FRANCE - The group went after oil storages this day in an attack into Southern France. The 306th flew 36 A/C in the 40th "B" group and 6 A/C in the 40 "C" group. No enemy A/C were seen. The target area was clear but clouds were encountered during part of the mission. Light flak was encountered at the French coast. Smoke was observed at St. Loubes.</p>
8.	<p>CAEN, FRANCE - Tactical targets south of the city and 1000 yards in advance of the front line British troops were the objectives. The 306th group flew 36 A/C as the 40 "C" and 12 A/C as the high squadron of the 40 "B". The high squadron of the "C" outfit brought back its bombs but all other groups dropped. Bombing was done from 14,000 feet and those of the lead and low squadrons hit very close to the LFI. Lt. Kata's crew, of the 369th had to bail out over the lines. Six of the crew landed in friendly territory and returned to the group within a couple of days. The other four men are MIA. S/Sgt. C.L. Dodson of the 369th was killed by flak. Sgt. Rees and Lt. Solfer of the 369th, Sgt. C.R. Chase and P.A. Clites of the 367th, and T/Sgt. R.J. Schonkas and Sgt. A.J. Mandeloro of the 368th were wounded.</p>
9	<p>ULM, Germany - The 306th, flying 36 A/C of the 40th "A" group under the command of Major Chalfant, started for Munich. Intense weather was encountered over northwestern Germany and all groups turned around except the 306th. Major Chalfant led them on into the target area where conditions were found to be extremely bad. The secondary target at Ulm was picked and a run was made. Although pictures were taken nothing can be ascertained because of the dense cloud cover which necessitated a PFF run.</p>

12	GRANVILLE, FRANCE A/D - After a two day rest because of the weather conditions over the continent, Major Ode led 35 A/C from the 36th group to France as the 40th "B" group. Conditions were very good and the weather was entirely clear at the target. Photos taken of the bombing show excellent results.
13	ROUSEY AREA, FRANCE - Another ground support job was run into France in support of the troops attempting to trap the German armies in the Falaise-Argentan pocket. Major Flanagan led the 36 A/C which formed the 40th "B" group. Results of the bombing were good. Although some of the squadrons failed to hit their assigned TPI's, all bombs were placed on important roads junctions. Moderate to intense flak was encountered in the vicinity of Flers. Lt. C.J. Stanton and Lt. W.H. Allen of the 367th were wounded by flak.
14	FICHENNES, JULACHE A/D, CHIEVRES A/D - When the primary target at Stuttgart was found to be obscured by bad weather, the 36 A/C of the 40th "B" group bombed targets of opportunity in Southeastern France. Lt. Col. Riordan's formation was able to bring back good pictures of their work.
15	FRANKFORT-ESCHBORN A/D - Only 22 A/C of the 40th "B" group were able to get off the ground on this mission. On the take off, Lt. Smith of the 369th crashed because of bad weather and rough air. All other take offs were cancelled. Of the crew that crashed, 5 were killed, three injured, and one escaped unhurt. When the target, on the north west edge of the city was reached, our TPI was found to be already obscured by smoke of previous bombings. The TPI was shifted to another part of the field and very good results were obtained. Fighters were seen to hit the wing immediately in trail of ours but we escaped unscathed.
16	BOHLEN, GERMANY - 35 A/C of the 40th "B" group bombed this synthetic oil plant under the leadership of Major Salada. Although strikes were registered on the TPI, two planes were lost and 18 others severely damaged. Lts. Y.B.C. Howson and Eldon L. Halstin went down with their crews in the target area. A few chutes were seen.
20	Capt. W.E. Keating assigned as operations officer of the 367th squadron.
24	LEISENBURG AND VORDE A/D - In the continued pounding of synthetic oil plants by the 8th AAF, this group flew 36 A/C of the 40 "B" group to Merseburg to bomb the I.G. Farben Industrie. Because of a heavy ground haze, the lead dropped on the rain plant instead of the TPI which was the power station east of the plant. A great deal of flak was encountered in the area. The low squadron bombed the Vorde A/D as they were cut out on their bomb run on the primary by another group. During the rendezvous, a smoke bomb in the lead snip, piloted by Major Chalfant, went off and he was forced to return to the field as four of his crew bailed out in the ensuing confusion. Lt. Ryle, the deputy lead took over and successfully lead the group to the target.
25	PEENEBUND-STRAHLUND A/D - 36 A/C flew as the 40th "B" under the lead of Major Flanagan. All squadrons made a run on the primary but only the high dropped as the other squadrons had trouble locating the TPI or rack malfunctions in the lead snip. These two squadrons made runs on the secondary, Strahlund A/D and successfully bombed it.

	<p>an intense barrage of flak was encountered by the low squadron. The high squadron's bombs hit directly on the IPI. Sgt. T.F. Hagg of the 307th was killed by flak. Lt. A.P. Trimble of the 307th and Sgt. B. S. Dykeman of the 306th were wounded by enemy fire.</p>
26	<p>GRUBENTHORN, GERMANY - The 306th made its first trip into the Ruhr Valley since the end of April. The group went in at a very high altitude and the high and lead squadrons had little trouble with the intense barrage of flak which was thrown up. Only the high squadron was able to identify enemy ground detail to drop bombs. The target area was partially obscured by low clouds, haze, and a smoke screen. The other two squadrons returned their bombs. Lt. D.C. Allen and crew of the 306th were seen to go down in the target area. Three minutes were seen. S/Sgt. D.L. McCarty and S.J. Bennett of the 306th were wounded by flak. 30, 500 Bkw up</p>
27	<p>WILHELMSHAVEN, GERMANY - The 306th flew 20 A/C as the lead and low squadrons of the 40th "A" group with the primary target as Berlin. Weather reports reported the area as impenetrable so Major Calcutt decided to bomb a last resort of Wilhelmshaven. A PFF run was begun on the town and three minutes before bombs away, Lt. Fyfe, the deputy lead, took over because of a failure of the lead team's equipment. Results were obscured because of the 10/10 undercut.</p>
30	<p>KIEL, GERMANY - An uneventful trip was made to bomb the shipyards at Kiel by 30 A/C of the 306th group and flew as the 40th "A" group. Major Oule led the mission which was a PFF run on the center of the industrial area of the town. Flak was very ineffective and results were obscured by clouds.</p>
	<p>In a month characterized by the heavy attacks on oil refineries and associated installations, the 306th group dropped 1161 tons of HE bombs and 142 tons of incendiaries. 147 nickels were dropped. On the 17 missions flown during the month 624 planes were dispatched of which 563 attacked the target. Only four aircraft were lost to enemy action with two of those going on the Berlin raid of the 16th. One of the features of the raids were the several short runs made as ground support work to British troops. On the raid of the eighth, one plane went down at six miles of the area and their way back to the base within a couple of days. Weather prevented raids on several days and incendiaries were loaded when the primary was impenetrable on the occasions. Fifteen of the bombers were visual sightings and the PFF. Results, in general, were good. No 2/A were encountered.</p>
