- at Berlin. Due to weather and various other factors at rendezvous all of our A/C returned to base except six ships of the 369th Squadren which tagged on to the 305% Group leader and flow high squadren in this fermation. Bombs were dropped on the leader through a break in the clouds about five miles S.E. of Bonn. No E/A were seen, A.A. fire was slight and inaccurate, bending results were unobserved.
