Fred W. Anderson, 367th Squadron navigator died 11 Dec. 1990 at Ames, Iowa. He arrived at Thurleigh in late August 1944, and on 7 January, 1945 completed 35 missions with 282 combat hours. He served with the Air Transport Command until his discharge in October, 1945. Since his retirement in 1980 he had lived in West Des Moines, Iowa and Venice, Florida.
