





The Echoe you sent has the piece on Colonel Sutton's silver box. I got to know him quite well. I traveled to England in early 1942 as a firstt Sargeant in one of the squadrons of the 92nd Bomb Group which was commanded by Sutton. On arrical at Bovington Jim was relieved of his command. He was in disrepute for a couple of years before being given command of the 306th. IYou must have the story of his sudden departure from the 92nd.

We were married in London in Church of Scotland. I recall Eve was furnished a beautiful wedding gown by American Red Cross. The only cost was dry cleaning. As I recall this was only done for American girls - oiurs was not made from parachute

I was not able to reach Jim Venable at the number you gave me.Have a grand time n Thurleigh
