Col. Overacker was the first group C.O., followed by Armstrong, Putnam, Robinson, Sutton and Upham.

I've had correspondence with Max Judas, who is now living in Tennessee and running a cattle ranch. He stayed in service to retire as a colonel.

Back to Milson, there was also another Wilson in the early days, Col. Delmar Wilson, who was deputy c.o. for a while and then transferred in early 1943. Heb later became a major general.
