Once Nedy came, Everett Daniel-Crewchief, never had a ship come back after nine missions. According to Everett, the 8th U.S., 1st Wing, had a celebration at Thurligh when "Stedy Nedy" completed a 100 missions - the first plane, B-17G, to do so in the Eighth U.S.

Perhaps Everett Daniel could tell you how many Nedy flew before retirement.
