He married Ruby Odell on Jan. 19, 1944, in Dallas, and she died in 1977. He married Lois E.<sup>6</sup> Miner on Feb. 27, 1982, in Rockport.

Deets was retired from the U.S. Air Force in 1960, and was with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. He was a member of George Reeves Masonic Lodge No. 396, A.F.&A.M.; served in the U.S. Army from 1935 to '38; played minor league baseball in the Cincinnati Reds organization from 1936 to '39; served in the U.S. Air Force from 1940 to 1960; and was a member of Calvary Baptist Church in Bonham.

Deets was a waist gunner on a 3-17 over Germany during World War II. He won the DFC and Air Medal with four oak leaf clusters.

His baseball days included stints with Savoy in the Red River League where he was seen by Reds scout Hank Severeid. He played with Muskogee, Okla., in 1938, and Waterloo, Iowa, in the Three-I League in 1939. He was sold to Indianapolis in 1940, and later assigned to Durham, N.C., but service in World War II interrupted his career.

He pitched for the Armed Forces camp championship nine in 1944, and was nominated for inlusion in the Fannin County Sports Hall of Fame in August of his year.

Survivors include his wife; on John III of Pottsboro; laughters Jan Marotz of Corpus Dhristi, Judy Nix and Helen Iohenberger, both of Irving; two rothers, Clifford of San Diego, Lalif., and George Frelan of Bonam; seven grandchildren and wo great-grandchildren.

He still had the old stamina and "smoke" on the ball to win both games -- a great accomplishment to end a very colorful and successful baseball career as a pitcher.

Deets retired from the Air Force after 20 years, in 1960. He then worked for 19 years for the Corps of Engineers in Denison.

John Deets is currently in a VA hospital in Buffalo, N.Y.


