Its many years late but I just became aware of the 306 B.G. Historical Assoc. and would like to become a member.

I completed 35 missions with the 367<sup>th</sup> Sqdn., 306<sup>th</sup> Bomb Group out of Thurleigh England. I was stationed at that Base from August 1944 to March 1945. My ASN 19100820, I was a Flight Engineer & Top Turret operator, with the rank of Tech. Sgt.

My Pilot was Emmett Sutherland and the Co-pilot was J.K. Field. Most of our missions were flown in "The Rose of York". I still corepond with the radio operator, one waist gunner and the tail gunner. As they have not mentioned the Historical Assoc. I don't believe they have any knowledge of it, so will relay the information.

Emmette B. (Bud) Sutherland passed away on April 30 1984.

John K. (Kemper) Field after being discharged in the 40's returned to the AIR Force and was killed in a plane crash in 1952.
