In response to your letter, you didn't know which "rock" to look under in the Washington area, and strangely none of your correspondents knew either.

According to my records, Capt! William C. McKee III is indeed buried in The Netherlands. There is only one American cemetery there and it is in Margraten, close to the eastern border of The Ntherlands.

Now, where hyou can get help in the Washington area is from the American Battle Momuments Commission. I am enclosing a copy of a page out of a 1985 publication which tells about the cemetery at Margaresn and there is a small map which shows its location.

I believe their offices have moved since my folder was printed, so I would suggest you get some help from the Arlington Library as to an address as well as a current telephone #, so that you can contact them.

My listing is not explicit, but my suspicion is that his name appears on a large memorial showing the names of those menwido were lost in that area, and as his plane came down in the water, I think it is doubtful that his body was recovered.

ABMC will be able to give you the mailing address of the Margraten cemetery, and if I read their pamphlet correctly, they will be able to send you a picture of your brother's name on the memorial at no charge.

Also.

Also, I am enclosing some further data on the mission which claimed your brother's life, and which may be helpful for the Ohio memorial committee. If they might wish to contact me, please provide them with my address, and I will be happy to do what I can for them.

I am also enclosing a copy of our Association quarterly newspaper which includes on page 5 a picture of your brother's crew.

The 306th Bomb Group Association is happy to assist you in your quest.
