I am Writing you to first off Thanks for the sending me the 306 Echoes every \(\frac{1}{4} \) Yr. as I enjoy reading it. The Jan. issue surprised me to find my crew navigator's Obituaries Namee Philip Tomasella has passed. Yes, he was with Charles Trigg crew, and darned good pal, He did something for me when I was WIA on a raid over Germany, Apr. 24, I was pretty bad shape when a ME 109 shell exploded through the bomb bay and nailed me in the R. Hip and L. Buttock, But I was very lucky tyey missed the bones. I spent about 3 wks. at the 49 Sta. Hospital. After all these years they found some Bits still in me although I feel, only cronic back achs almost daily. I go to the VA hospital regularly. Now, About Phill, Hehelped ease the worrying by sending my family a letter explaining my injuries. The WAR Dept, don't give much information.

Allthese years gone by and I cannot remember all the crews names, I do know that our Ball Tr. was a guy by name of Murdock, He was taken POW, flying with another crew. I was also flying with a different crew, but I still don't know which they were, I was ROMG, filling in for a man on Sick call. We were anew crew just sterting in combat, I only flew 2 missions, it was the second one for me. It all happened on The 24 Apr, 44. We were to drop bombs over An Aircraft and the Enemy fighters came after us, The name was Oberhaphen ??.

I lost my wife to cancer in --92 and I am Getting on in age 80+. We were with the 168 Sq. and I was sent to the USA in Oct. of that year, Once back, we were sent to Radio school for refresher training. then the A Bomb was dropped, almost over, just waiting discharg. Out in Oct. 30-45

If you have any information, as to Names, lost planes, or any thing about

my Combat History, I would appreiate the Info.

I live alone, have two kids, one in Reno and the girl in Texas

PS- I type cause my hands are disabled-Tremors
