Thank you for your letter of August 6<sup>th</sup>. I have 7 double pages of photos (14 photos) which I will send direct to your daughter-in-law by Priority Mail and then she can mail them back to me. Ha. This way we eliminate the middle-man.

I wish I could find the rest of the 306<sup>th</sup> photos I possessed at one time. I vividly remember one photo showing a V-2 rocket that was launched and in flight as the 306<sup>th</sup> planes were over the launch site.

The crews came back from that mission claiming the Germans were shooting telephone poles at them.

One thing has been nagging at me and that is the permanency of the photos made with organic color dyes. The Cibachrome process, which is very expensive, uses metallic color dyes in their prints and they are supposed to last indefinitely. I don't know if the laser color copies are made with metallic color dyes. If so, they are a steal at the price being charged.

As soon as I receive your daughter-in-law's address, I'll mail her the photos.
