can Legion, Sylvania.

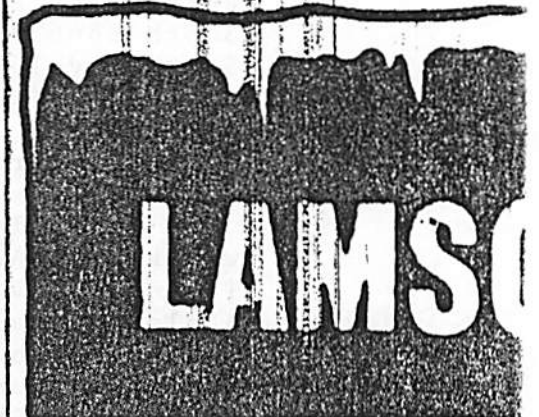
