SUNDAY - 19 December 1943 (cont.)

- 1020 Maj. Heston advises that simulated spy activities will be in operation today. This field and control towers will be subject to receiving them. They are to be regarded as spys and routine action to be taken upon identification.
- 1022 Lt. Wagner - 1st division here on visit
- 1110 Green passed to ops.
- 1130 Podington a/c 636 returned to base - our a/c 145 to Thurleigh
- 1145 Group ops advised gunnery mission for this afternoon
- 1230 on duty Capt. Haley.
- 1245 made routine inspection of aerodrome.
- 1345 arranged for clectros + maps to be here at 1520.
Pundit 213 is 4/5 - we operate for them. A-54.
- 1440 I owned Camms "AK" to pundit crew
- 1530 made arrangements for clectros map etc.
- 1545 wind S-S-W - 15 mph.
- 1645 Chelveston advises that 928 will not return to us today - brones are 4/5.
- 1730 advised Warton that 363-965-942 had landed. Flare pass laid R/W 24 met consulted.
- 1745 Pundit crew reports OK.
- 1800 On-duty - Lt. Heek.
- 1830 Routine inspection of aerodrome and lighting made - all in order.
- 1930 Ops advised "alert"
