- 0645 Passed green to Div.
- 1049 250 - Lt. Latham took off for Basinghouse  
will not return.
- 1230 Lt. Crowell on. Capt. Bradbury on.
- 1500 Engineers will work on south end of  
N-S R/W where it crosses perimeter track  
this afternoon. It will be completed by  
this evening.
- 2000 Airborne yellow - wind 38 mph - gusty.
- 2025 Standdown for tomorrow.
- 2130 Inspected general airborne area.
