For fullentry in action against an armed energy of the United States, while serving as Nose Gunner on a B-17 airplane on a bombing mission over enemy occupied territory, 1 may 1943. after completion of the bombing run enemy fighter planes attacked in large numbers, causing severe domage and starting in intense fire in the mid-section of the airplane. The condition of the plane was so serious that part of the crew bailed out. Displaying great bravery and skill, Sergeant Melaun, with utter disregard for his own safety, went into the radio compartment, which was a mass of flumes to aid the ball turnet and top turnet gunners in extinguishing the fire. After the fire was extinguished Sergeart Melaun returned to his nose guns and warded off repeated attacks by enemy fighter plenes.
